

KUL WICASA LAKOTA OSPIYE MEMBERS MOTION FOR REDRESS

This is a motion by the Kul Wicasa Lakota Ospiye Members, urging Lori Miner to recuse herself as Chief Judge of the Lower Brule Tribal Court, and avoid a conflict of interest, as Judge Lori Miner was appointed by one of the two opponent tribal council factions that are currently engaging in a power struggle. And to which, Judge Miners' husband Lee Brennan, Tribal Manager, is a third party to the Tribal Council Power Struggle.

The alternative, to Judge Lori Miner's recusal is banishment, under the authority of Traditional Lakota Custom, and Article I of the 1868 Fort Laramie Treaty.

Because Lori Miner is a non-Indian and an illegal Tribal Judge, according to Article VII, Section 2, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Lower Brule Sioux Tribe, Judge Lori Miner is not only trespassing on the Lower Brule Sioux Indian Reservation, but is also trespassing on the Lakota Ospiye Member's Treaty Rights, and their inherent Sovereignty, the right to be self-governing. It is also illegal for Lori Miner to appoint B.J. Jones as the appellate court judge.

Lori Miner, Lee Brennan, and B.J. Jones will be banished from the Lower Brule Reservation as of 12:00 noon, January 8, 2015.
