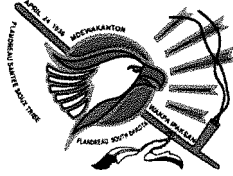

**Flandreau Santee Sioux Tribe- FSST Scholarships & Grants**

Award: Varies

Eligibility: *BIA AVT grant:* 18-35 year old PSST tribal member or member of a federally recognized tribe living within 50 miles of Tribal headquarters and in need of training. *BIA Higher Education Grant* and the *FSST Higher Education/AVT Scholarships:* PSST Tribal member; see handbook for additional requirements (Available in the Education Office).

Deadline: Fall Semester (early-August); Spring Semester (late-December) (Quarter system - contact Education Office)

**Dakota Indian Foundation**

Award: Varies based on need

Eligibility: Lakota, Dakota, or Nakota heritage; full-time, sophomore, junior or senior. Minimum 2.5 GPA.

Deadline: January 15<sup>th</sup> for Spring Funding; August 1<sup>st</sup> for Fall Funding

Notes: Includes Nyal Brings Scholarship (open to Graduate students with degree related to American Indian Studies)

**Daughters of the American Revolution - American Indian Scholarship**

Award: One time \$4000

Eligibility: American Indian (proof required); financial need; Minimum 3.25 GPA. Undergraduate and graduate levels

Deadline: Postmarked by January 31st

**Morris K. Udall Undergraduate Scholarship**

Award: Up to \$7500

Eligibility: College Sophomores and juniors interested in leadership, public service; American Indian - Enrolled or proof of descent; interest in tribal policy issues in Indian Country, health care, or environment

Deadline: March 4, 2026

Notes: Must be nominated by faculty representative from your institution of learning (see website for more criteria); website also includes internship and other program opportunities
