

LOWER BRULE SIOUX TRIBE ADVERTISEMENT OF VACANT POSITION LOWER BRULE CORPORATION BOARD

QUALIFICATIONS REQUIRED:

- Each nominee for Director of the Corporation shall be evaluated upon his/her capability, to advise the Board of Corporation concerning its responsibilities as a holding company for the voting shares of various subsidiaries engaged in a variety of business activities and who is familiar with the business, health, welfare, social well-being and self-determination interests of the Tribe, and with the legitimate business interests of investors and debt providers.
- No person that has been convicted of a felony involving violence or lack of integrity, shall sit on the Board, including conviction of a crime against children, a crime involving fraud, embezzlement, theft, conversion of money or property, misrepresentation, misuse of funds, use of a dangerous weapon, sexual misconduct and the like. A “felony” shall mean a crime punishable by, at least one (1) year in jail, regardless of whether the person actually served a full year in jail.
- No person who has been convicted of any crime involving theft or conversion of money or property shall sit on the Board.
- No employee of the Corporation, or the Bureau of Indian Affairs, or Indian Health Service shall be eligible to serve as a Director during the time of such employment.
- Members of the Tribal Council shall be eligible to serve as a Director of the Corporation.
- Nonmembers of the Tribe shall not constitute a majority of the Board. Nonmembers may constitute a majority of a quorum of the Board.
- No more than two members of the Board may be nonmembers of the Tribe.
