CONDITIONAL ORDER FOR
SPECIAL ELECTION

KEVIN WRIGHT, SONNY ZIEGLER,

A hearing was scheduled in this case on the 23rd day of October 2015 on the Plaintiffs' motion for a restraining order and for an order invalidating certain actions taken by the Defendants at a Tribal Council meeting held in Rapid City, South Dakota in September of 2015. The Defendants' former counsel, Steven Emery, withdrew from representation and counsel Chase Iron Eyes appeared for the Defendants. The Plaintiff's appeared through attorney Terry Pechota. Counsel asked for additional time to submit legal arguments since Mr. Iron Eyes just got involved. The Court indicated it would permit the Parties until October 30 to submit any additional arguments.


The Court also visited with counsel and the Parties about an ultimate resolution of the dispute before the Court. After a lunch recess the parties indicated that they had reached a stipulation. Both sides submitted a name to replace the deceased Chairman and agreed to a special election to replace the Chairman. Each side indicated it would propose an entity to monitor the election. The Defendants indicated that their agreement to the

proposal is conditioned upon the Lower Brule Court of Appeals affirming this Court's decision regarding the number of votes necessary to pass resolutions and that the election could be held if the Court affirms this Court's ruling in CIV #14-12-0119.


WHEREFORE based upon the stipulation read into the record it is hereby ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that if the Lower Brule Sioux Tribal Court of Appeals affirms this Court's decision that 4 votes are necessary to pass resolutions by the Lower Brule Sioux Tribal Council, or if the Court dismisses that appeal without reversing this Court, a special election shall be held within 30 days of the Court of Appeals' action between Lewis Grassrope and Boyd Gourneau for the position of Chairman of the Lower Brule Sioux Tribe. Each party shall submit the name of a proposed entity to oversee said election on or before October 30, 2015, and it is further

ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED that the Parties have until October 30, 2015 to submit any closing arguments on the question of whether this Court should invalidate the actions of the Defendants at a Council meeting purportedly held in Rapid City, South Dakota in September of 2015.


