#### American Indian Services (AIS)

The AIS Scholarship program is to help undergraduate Native American/Alaska Native students with financial support to attend a college or university, maintain enrollment, and graduate. Submit your application, today! Take note, this is due soon.

DEADLINE - NOV 1

### Cooke Foundation College Scholarship Program

The Cooke College Scholarship provides up to \$55,000 per year plus advising and nationwide scholar support for high-achieving students with financial need. Open to high school seniors with a 3.75+ GPA. Apply today!

DEADLINE - NOV 16

### Point Foundation - The Flagship Scholarship

The Flagship Scholarship supports LGBTQ+ and ally students pursuing bachelor's, graduate, or professional degrees. Recipients receive financial assistance based on need, leadership development opportunities, and access to a nationwide community of LGBTQ+ scholars and alumni. Renewable for up to four years.

DEADLINE - NOV 20

### Pride Foundation Scholarships

Pride Foundation offers scholarships for LGBTQ+ students in the Northwest, with priority for those who have faced barriers such as racism, transphobia, disability, rural isolation, or financial hardship. Over 50 scholarships are available for students pursuing education after high school in AK, ID, MT, OR, and WA.

**DEADLINE - JAN 9** 

#### The United South and Eastern Tribes (USET) Scholarship Fund

USET offers equal scholarship awards to undergraduate and graduate students from the 33 USET Tribal Nations, with selection based on academic standing and enrollment or acceptance at a post-secondary institution.

**DEADLINE - JAN 15** 

#### The CAPTRUST Scholarship

CAPTRUST will award five \$2,000 scholarships for Spring 2026 to students across the country. These scholarships support developing professionals and reflect CAPTRUST's commitment to investing in community and student success.

**DEADLINE - NOV 28** 

#### The Native American Scholarship Fund

The Native American Scholarships Endowment Fund provides multiple awards for Indigenous students pursuing archaeology, cultural preservation, or museum studies. Scholarships support undergraduate, graduate, and training programs, with funding available for tuition, living costs, research, and childcare. Open to Native American, Alaska Native, Native Hawaiian, Indigenous Pacific Islander, and First Nations students.

**DEADLINE - JAN 30** 

#### **Intertribal Timber Council**

Sponsored by the Intertribal Timber Council. Dedicated to the support of Native American students pursuing a higher education in Natural Resources, Forestry, & Fire.

**DEADLINE - MARCH 20** 

#### The Reisher Scholars Program

The Reisher Scholars Program supports Colorado students who are already in college or transferring from community college, helping them stay on track to complete their degree. This scholarship is for motivated students with financial need who demonstrate leadership and academic potential.
