Re: School Status Report - February

The second semester has been off to a great start. Included below are some highlights since the start of second semester.

#### Enrollment and Staffing

- Lower Brule Schools enrollment continues to be steady with 320 students in 1st semester, with an ADM of 310 students and a 89% attendance rate. We are working to try and improve attendance percentage.
- Our ES Administrative Assistant has resigned, rather than replace the position, I have reassigned Lauralei
  Freeman to the position and she will continue to work with the Superintendent's Office to fulfill Federal
  compliance reports. This is a cost savings move in anticipation of possible cuts in the upcoming Federal
  budget.
- Our new 1<sup>π</sup> grade teacher began duties in January. This allowed us to re-organize and ensure we have certified teachers in KG-6<sup>th</sup> grade at the Elementary School. It also allowed us to shift our uncertified KG teacher into a librarian/reading interventionist position which has really showing growth with our young readers.
- We have secured Roman Lacho as a digital media specialist instructor for the school. He has been certified by the SD DOE as a CTE instructor. We will share this position 2/3 and 1/3 with Lower Brule Community College. We are in final process of securing his work visa.

#### Curriculum and Instruction

I have attached a data sheet showing Fall and Winter NWEA Map Testing results. NWEA Map Testing is required by the BIE to be conducted 3 times per academic year as part of their accountability program. The data shows progress from Fall of this academic year to Winter. EXAMPLE –

The trend data shows growth was made. (see attached data sheet)

- We are awaiting the funding awarded for Enhancement Funds. BIE officials said they have made their determination but are awaiting funds.
- We have produced a draft school calendar for 2018-2019 (see attached). We believe the calendar has worked
  well this year for students and staff. Creating a more focused approach and providing periodic breaks when
  necessary.
- Lower Brule Research Institute -
- February Staff Development Days The first day will be spent working with testing data, organizational, and divisional needs. Day two will be with the the <u>Woope Sakowin</u> (Seven Laws). This workshop will provide teachers with the tools to transform their classrooms into positive, safe and brave environments, foster trusting relationships and teach valuable life skills.

#### **Activities**

- Basketball Teams are having a successful winter season. The Lady Sloux are 13-3 currently ranked #1 in the region. The girls captured 1<sup>st</sup> place at the DOC tournament. The Sloux are 10-6 currently ranked #2 in the region. The Boys captured their 3<sup>rd</sup> consecutive Championship at DOC. If things continue both teams will be hosting post season games and have a very good chance of making the sweet 16.
- 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> Grade and Middle School Boys are having successful seasons as well. They both have winning records. They have done well in multiple tournaments.

#### **Facilities**

We are thankful for the facilities we have. However, we still awaiting funding to make essential improvements
to our overall facilities. I believe an improvement to our facilities would attract more students to Lower Brule
Schools.
