

September 2, 2015 the Lower Brule Sioux Tribal Council met for the regular scheduled Tribal Council meeting. During this meeting, Vice Chairman Kevin Wright while presiding as chairman tried to vote to approve a motion. Article IV Section 4 of the Lower Brule Sioux Tribe By-Laws specifically states:

In all instances, resolution, or motions the duly elected councilmen may act by two third (2/3) majority vote of the full Tribal Council, but all matters of importance shall be fully discussed and a reasonable attempt shall be made to secure unanimous agreement. The Chairman shall only vote to break a tie. (Amendment II and V, September 2, 1986)

The Secretary/Treasurer called for point of order to inform the Vice Chairman he could not vote. He disagreed and proceeded on with the meeting. The Secretary/Treasurer informed him that he would not participate in a meeting that was not following the Tribal Constitution and excused himself from the meeting. John McCauley left shortly after due to the loss of quorum and unprofessional conduct.

On September 3, 2015 or September 8, 2015 Kevin Wright, Desiree Laroche, and Sonny Ziegler held a special meeting in Rapid City without notifying the Secretary Treasurer or John McCauley. Once again, there was not a quorum present for the meeting to be deemed official. **Please see attached minutes of the illegal actions taken at this meeting.** They have again violated the restraining order by holding illegal meetings and producing illegal documents.

Article IV Section 2 of the Lower Brule Sioux Tribe By-Laws specifically states:

SECTION 2. Quorum. No business shall be transacted unless a quorum is present. A quorum shall consist of five (5) council members. (Amendment II and V, September 2, 1986)

ARTICLE IV – MEETINGS

SECTION 1. The regular meeting of the Tribal Council shall be held the first Wednesday of each month at the Lower Brule Community Hall or such other place on the reservation designated by the Tribal Council. Special meetings may be called by the Chairman or by the majority of the Tribal Council and when so called the Tribal Council shall have the power to transact business as in regular meetings. (Amendment II and V, September 2, 1986)

These Council members have created fraudulent minutes and resolutions that are being passed off to the public and our bank causing great confusion and possible illegal access to federal funds.
