Charges and Complaints against the Lorrie Minor acting Chief Judge for the Lower Brule Sioux Tribe.

First of all the Lakota Kul Wicasa Ospiye Treaty descendants who are also members of the 1934 IRA Lower Brule Sioux Tribe are not a party to the 2014 Tribal Council power struggle, that has crippled the Lower Brule Sioux Tribe for the past 15 months.

The reason the Lower Brule Tribal Court cannot resolve the tribal council power struggle is because the Tribal Court is illegitimate, according to the Constitution of the Lower Brule Sioux Tribe. In September 1986 the Lower Brule Sioux Tribe amended their Constitution requiring that all Tribal Judges be elected by the voting members of the tribe.

Mrs. Minor has been appointed as Chief Judge for the passed 3 years. All 1934 IRA Tribal Constitution are amended by secretarial elections, because the constitutional amendments are under the United States Secretary of Interior Department it is in fact a federal election. To which U.S. federal voter rights apply. Considering the fact that tribal constitutional amendments are by secretarial elections and Lorrie Minor is a non-indian. This would be a case for U.S. District Court or Traditional Tribal Justice Forum. Mrs. Lorrie Minor has been banished from the Lower Brule Reservation by the Kul Wicasa Ospiye Treaty Descendants. MOTION FOR REDRESS

This is a motion by The Council of Elders of the Lower Brule Lakota Ospiye, urging Lori Miner to recuse herself as Chief Judge of the Lower Brule Tribal Court, and avoid a conflict of interest, as Judge Lori Miner was appointed by one of the two opponent tribal council factions that are currently engaging in a power struggle. And to which, Judge Miners' husband Lee Brennan, Tribal Manager, is a third party to the Tribal Council Power Struggle

The alternative, to Judge Lori Miner's recusal is banishment, under the authority of Traditional Lakota Custom, and Article I of the 1868 Fort Laramie Treaty

Because Lori Miner is a non-Indian and an illegal Tribal Judge, according to Article VII, Section 2, of the Constitution and By-Laws of the Lower Brule Sioux Tribe, Judge Lori Miner is not only trespassing on the Lower Brule Sioux Indian Reservation, but is also trespassing on the Lakota Ospiye Member's Treaty Rights, and their inherent Sovereignty, the right to be self-governing. Furthermore, Lori Miner has no legal authority to appoint B.J. Jones, the appellate court judge.
